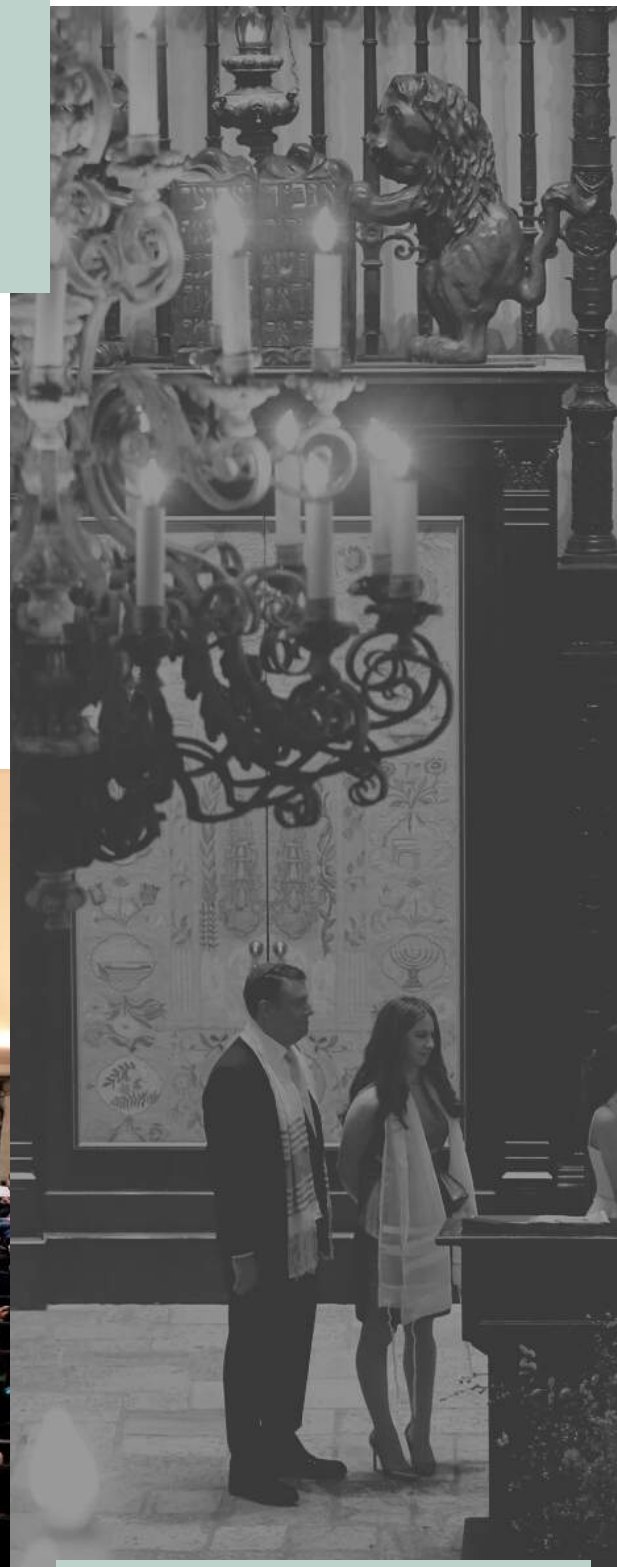


About

The Grounds

Perfectly situated on nine acres nestled in bucolic Bedford Corners our Ceremony Lawn is the natural, plein-air centerpiece of the Temple. The lawn is beautifully manicured and equipped with power,

Our event spaces feature five arched windows in the Social Hall and six in the JHC that bathe the room in light with space for 200 people.



The Sanctuary

The Sanctuary has space for 250 people and features 10 beautiful stained glass windows. What is now our Sanctuary was first created as a music room, constructed on the principle of the violin, with a separate floor, inner walls, and wooden ceiling, all of which resonate vibration without echoes. The inspiration for the music room came from the San Pietro, built in the 16th century in Perugia, Italy.

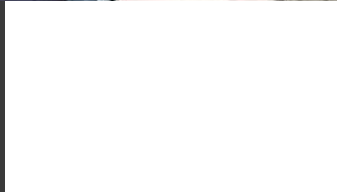
Every new baby or adopted child entering the Temple Shaaray Tefila community is a blessing to the congregational family, and our clergy are delighted to provide support during this wonderful time in your life.

If you have a boy, a bris (or brit, the Hebrew word for “covenant,” here referring to the covenant of circumcision), takes place on the eighth day after birth.

If you have a girl, a baby naming may be celebrated at any time — although many families choose to hold it on the eighth day after birth, similar to a bris.

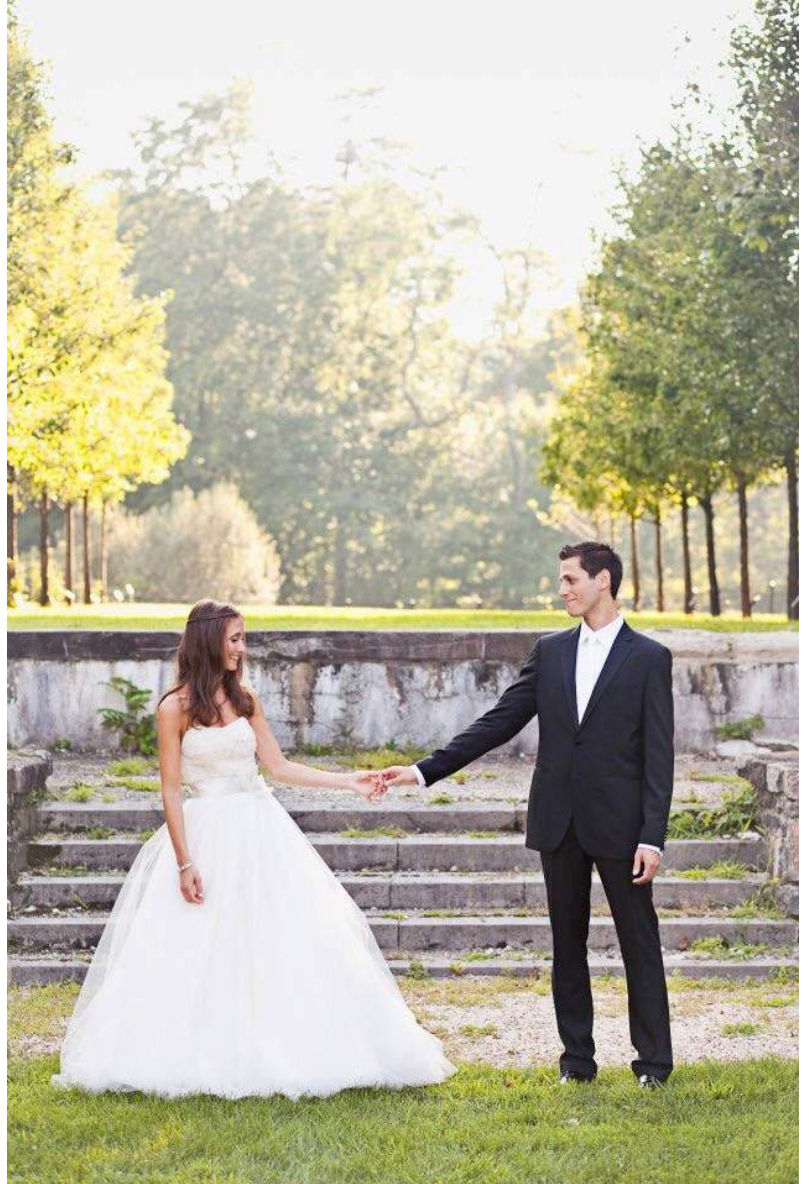

FAQ

Capacity: We have a capacity of 175-200 for a seated reception. During Spring and Summer we can accommodate additional people by tenting the patio. All B'nai Mitzvah parties that include more than 50 children and any other party with more than 100 people in attendance receive a security guard. If more than 50 children, a second security guard is required at the cost of the member family.

Grounds: Use of the Temple's playground during events is strictly forbidden.

Food: The serving of pork products and shellfish is strictly forbidden.

Time limits: Morning events must end by 4pm and the room completely clear of furniture and decorations by 4:30pm. Saturday evening events must end by midnight and the room completely clear of furniture and decorations by 12:30am.

Kosher: We can Kosher the kitchen upon request.

Do I need to use a specific vendor: No, but we have a list of vendors we have worked with and know to be excellent.

What is your alcohol policy: All types of alcohol are permitted.

Can you accommodate physically challenged guests: Yes, there is a ramp leading to the Social Hall and the Sanctuary.

Tents: Tents are allowed on the patio off the Social Hall and on the lawn behind the school. We cannot allow tents between the Main Building and Sanctuary.

Photos: There is no flash photography allowed during services except by professional photographers.

Deliveries: Vendors may not make deliveries on Fridays.
